THE CHALLENGE

TMO Traffic Highways Ltd are fully committed to reducing their environmental impact. As an ISO:14001 accredited business, they recognised that weekly battery changes and the vehicle mileage involved were a major contributor to CO2 emissions, fuel costs, and wasted resources across the Traffic Management industry.

When awarded a year-long contract with BAM Nuttall in Suffolk, Operations Director Ben Green (TechIOSH, AIEMA, NCRQCert) saw an opportunity to trial a new solution that could significantly cut emissions while improving efficiency.

THE SOLUTION

TMO worked closely with BAM Nuttall to gain approval for the trial of the Nissen LZA550 Solar Lights. Over a 12-week period, the lights were monitored using the Trackit247 Ltd tracker service provided by ITS, which tracked battery levels and performance remotely.

The results were impressive:

- No battery changes required
- No low-voltage warnings
- Consistently strong voltage levels (12.7–13v)
- Zero breakdowns or communication failures

By eliminating weekly battery swaps and the associated travel, the technology delivered both operational savings and a measurable environmental benefit.

THE RESULTS

In the first 12 weeks:

- 611kg of CO2 saved
- £48 electricity saved
- 912 vehicle miles avoided

Predicted over one year:

- 2,648kg of CO2 saved
- £208 electricity saved
- 3,952 vehicle miles avoided
